DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Surface Preparation – All surface coatings and sealers must be removed by using INCRETE UNI-STRIPP or by sand blasting or other mechanical means. Surface to be coated must be structurally sound and clean, free from oil, grease, and any other bond-breakers. Oil and grease should be removed with INCRETE GREASE-A-WAY and water rinsing the surface until thoroughly clean. Surface must be profiled by mechanical means or by acid-etching (5 parts water to 1 part muriatic acid solution). Extremely hard, tight finished or polished concrete may require a second application with stronger solution or additional mechanical profiling. Rinse surface thoroughly with clean water and let dry completely before applying Bond-Crete.

Procedure – Apply BOND-CRETE liberally over entire surface with a roller, making sure not to leave any puddled areas. Let dry before applying overlay. Product will be tacky. NOTE: Extremely porous surfaces will require 2 coats, first coat must dry completely before applying second coat.

CLEAN-UP

Clean tools and equipment with detergent and water immediately following use. Clean drips and over-spray with water while still wet. Dried BOND-CRETE may require mechanical abrasion for removal.

PRECAUTIONS/LIMITATIONS

- Do not use BOND-CRETE where constant moisture or hydrostatic pressure is present (swimming pools, cisterns or other areas that will be immersed).
- Do not dilute BOND-CRETE.
- Keep from freezing.
- Do not apply to frozen or frost filled surfaces.
- Do not apply if temperature is below 50°F (10°C).
- Store at temperatures between 50°F to 90°F (10°C to 32°C).
- In all cases, consult the Material Safety Data Sheet before use.
